NRA SILHOUETTE SHOOTING We presently have some interest in shooting regular NRA Rimfire Rifle Silhouettes at Black Ash. A small committee is working on a suitable shooting spot on the club grounds and a set of rules. We do not plan on using the rifle range as we do not want to close it on a weekend. We hope to have a shoot in September or October. Contact Carl Pelino if you are interested or have questions. Plans are to keep this simple, fun, and safe. Steel targets are shot offhand at distances of 40, 60, 77, and 100 meters. Targets vary in size and include chickens (40 meters), pigs (60 meters), turkeys (77 meters), rams (100 meters). We plan to follow NRA rules for these shoots except for rifle classifications. We will probably develop our own classification system so we don't have to weigh rifles and check trigger pulls. This will not be an event that is sanctioned to qualify for competition at higher levels but it will be lots of fun and great rifle practice. RIFLE RANGE

Summer is rapidly coming to an end and the use of the rifle range is increasing as people begin to look forward to hunting season. As our economy has weakened there has been an increased use of the range by non members who are reluctant to donate a dollar for that privilege and who tend to ignore the posted safety rules. Please remember to carry your

membership card to the range so that you can quickly prove your membership. Many non members tell range officers they are members in an attempt to shoot for free. If you observe a violation of the safety rules, please politely ask the violator to correct their behavior. Following is a brief summary of the range rules.

- 1. No rapid fire. The two second rule helps to make sure that all shots are aimed and prevents stray shots from impacting in the residence areas behind the range.
- 2. Paper targets only. Targets must be affixed to the target boards.
- 3. No quick draw and shoot practice.
- 4. No human silhouette targets.
- 5. No shooting at targets on the ground. This rule prevents ricochets. Persons violating this rule will lose their range privileges.
- 6. All shooting must be from the established bench firing line.
- 7. All shooters will pick up their expended brass and remove their targets from the target boards.
- 8. Non member guests shall deposit \$1, in the range donation box BEFORE shooting.
- Possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages or controlled substances before or during shooting is prohibited. Violators of this rule will be evicted from the range and lose range privileges.

COOKS CORNER

Deer season is just around the corner and successful hunters will need to preserve their harvest. Most hunters preserve venison by freezing, but you might want to consider the time proven canning method. Canned venison is instantly available (no thawing time) and can be used in a variety of recipes. Here's a simple method for canning venison. Remove as much fat and fibrous tissue as possible from the meat and cut into one inch cubes. Wash meat with cold water and pack in sterilized pint jars. Add one half teaspoon uniodized salt and a small strip of bacon to each jar. Seal with sterilized lids and rings. Pressure can for 1 ½ hours at 11 pounds pressure or in a boiling water bath for three hours
