FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear Members,

2018 was another great year for Black Ash! I thank all of you who participated in any way and especially thank the volunteers who were there when we needed them to run our different matches and events, shovel snow, mow grass, fix things, keep the clubhouse clean, maintain shooting ranges, and all the other things that make a successful club work. The list of helpers is pretty long and that's what we need to keep things going and moving ahead.

We had good participation in our major activities. The number of shooters in the Winter Skeet League and Monday Night Trap League stayed pretty steady from 2017. This is important since these are two big fundraising activities each year. Unfortunately, participation was lower for the Handgun Adventure Trail Matches this past summer. This was mainly due to bad weather on almost every scheduled Sunday for a match. Tough to make up when there is only one match a month. The NRA Silhouette Matches did show a slight increase on numbers and income this year. The move to the rifle range and the addition of rope resets for the targets seemed to boost interest and participation. Hopefully the numbers here will continue to grow in 2019.

As we try to do each year, we did make some improvements to the club grounds in 2018. Lights were added to Field 2 for Trap and Skeet and to Field 3 for Trap. This will be a big help to the Maplewood Trap Team and will make it possible to increase shooter numbers in the Monday Night Trap League. For those of you who are neighbors please don't be concerned. We are not planning any all night or even late-night shooting activities. The lights will just enable shooting to continue into dusk when normally the targets become difficult to see.

Another positive thing we saw in 2018 is that our member numbers continue to grow. You are all doing a pretty god job of taking care of our facilities too. We have seen very little unnecessary damage at the rifle and pistol ranges and litter hasn't been a big problem either.

The rest of this newsletter describes all of the activities we have going on at Black Ash. If you as a member are not participating in at least one of these activities you should ask yourself why you are missing out on all of the fun!!! Besides having a great time shooting you will also be supporting the club so we can continue these activities and add more. Please keep in mind that these activities don't just happen without a lot of work from members. We need every

YOUTH PHEASANT HUNT

Saturday, October 13 marked the date of the Black Ash Sportsman's Club's 6th annual Youth Pheasant Hunt. As in past years, the Pennsylvania Game Commission helped sponsoring clubs throughout the state by providing pheasants (2 per registered hunter) as well as pre-hunt registration though their web site. We had a total of 12 hunters register this year (although only 9 turned out the morning of the hunt).

Our hunt day started early with a 7 a.m. kick-off meeting and safety talk at the clubhouse. We then adjourned out to the trap field after sunup to get each of the young hunters some practice shooting at clay targets. It was then off to the hunting fields where each group was accompanied by a guide and their dog (or dogs in some cases). While the weather conditions were not perfect—temps in the 40s and intermittent rain— it did not stop our hunt groups from spending a few hours afield at their designated hunt locations. Following the early morning hunt, all groups reported back to the clubhouse where we reorganized for the Black Ash 2nd Chance Hunt. During this hunt, we give each junior hunter who has not yet harvested a pheasant or those that are short of a limit to go back out for another change with pheasants supplied by Black Ash. When all was said and done, all nine of our hunters had very successful days with each hunter taking at least on pheasant and eight harvesting their limit of pheasants (this set a new Club record). On top of that, all hunters were safe, demonstrated ethical hunting practices and had fun. Following the hunting activities, we wrapped up the day with a lunch sponsored by the Black Ash Board of Directors. It takes many volunteers to make this event successful, and I would be remiss if I did not recognize this year's volunteer group.

MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL

There is an application as part of this newsletter for renewing your membership. In order to speed up receiving your new card, **PLEASE SEND YOUR DUES TO OUR TREASURER AT THE ADDRESS SHOWN AT THE BOTTOM OF THE APPLICATION**. If you mail your dues to the club address, it may be a week or two before our treasurer gets your payment. We don't have staff at the clubhouse to take care of this. Also, please include a stamped, self-addressed envelope with your dues. You may also renew your membership at any club activity.

2019 introduces a new FAMILY membership. We want to encourage families to spend time at the club together. The FAMI- LY membership allows you, your spouse or partner, and all youth who share your household at any time to gain membership to Black Ash Sportsman, Inc. for an annual fee of \$40. The FAMILY membership may also be used for a couple without any youth members to receive a \$10 discount below two adult memberships. The annual fee for a single adult membership is \$25, and a single youth membership is \$5. Per our bylaws, a life membership is twenty times the annual adult membership fee, or \$500. Please complete one application per membership type.

PISTOL LEAGUE

Black Ash participates in the multi-county VIP League (Very Informal Pistol League). The league was established to be a fun shooting experience for new and experienced shooters. We use modified rules for NRA Bullseye shooting to keep things lightly competitive and a lot of fun. Shooters can shoot in either the rimfire class or centerfire class or both. We shoot once a month starting in April at Black Ash. The league ends in September with all teams getting together for the only joint competition of the year.

We invite any member including ladies and juniors to join our team. There are no fees for the league but all shooters must provide their own handgun(s) and ammunition. We usually shoot as a team on the 2nd Thursday of each month (meeting night) beginning at 4:30. Shooters showing up by 5:30 will still be able to get on a relay and post scores.

HANDGUN ADVENTURE TRAIL

2019 Competition on the Handgun Adventure Trail will begin with a shoot on Sunday March 24, at 9:00 a.m. For those of you who have never done this it is about as much fun you can have (legally) with a gun! Events are open for 22 rifle and handgun and for centerfire handguns, all with either open sights or scopes. We even have a Golf Course for 22 rifles! Events through the summer are the 4th Sunday of the month. Scheduled matches for 2019 are: March 24, April 28, May 26, June 23, July 28, August 25, September 22, and October 27. <u>All competition rounds are open to members and non-members.</u>

All of the Adventure Trail courses will be open for practice rounds for members and accompanying guests starting in late February and will remain open through the summer, except for the week before the shoots and occasionally during special events at the club. Like Black Ash Sportsman, Inc on Facebook to find out exactly when the course opens for practice this season. Practice rounds are free to members and \$1 each round for guests with a member.

As with other events at the club we can use some member support as range officers, target painters, and at the registration table. NRA SILHOUETTE SHOOTING

We are hosting monthly NRA Silhouette Matches at Black Ash. The plans are to keep this relatively simple, fun and safe. For those of you who may not be familiar with this sport, steel targets are shot offhand at 40, 50, 75 and 100 meters. There are classes for rimfire rifles and handguns, centerfire handguns and centerfire rifles shooting handgun cartridges. All classes of shooters shoot the ½ scale targets.

There is a \$3 Guest Fee for using the ranges and a \$1 fee for GUESTS OF A MEMBER for practice rounds on the Handgun Adventure Trail. Fees must be paid before shooting begins. Please follow all range rules, especially safety rules and rules for target placement. We have had some problems with shooters hanging targets on upright posts and crossbars and shooting the cables at the pistol range.
