SHOOTING RANGES

We have been experiencing a little more damage than usual at our ranges, especially on the rifle range. Please follow all range rules to help keep our ranges safe and in good shape for all shooters. REMEMBER - NO PELLET SHOTGUN SHELLS SHOULD BE FIRED AT EITHER THE RIFLE OR HANDGUN RANGE BACKBOARDS. BESIDES DAMAGING THE BACKBOARDS, THEY ALSO POSE A SAFETY THREAT OF PELLETS BOUNCING BACK TOWARD THE SHOOTER! Please remove all targets after you are finished at the ranges. Don't leave targets hanging "for the next guy" just because you didn't shoot at them or they just have one or two holes. They just blow off the target boards and become litter on the range!!

Please follow all range rules, especially safety rules and rules for target placement. We have had some problems with shooters hanging targets on upright posts and crossbars and shooting the cables at the pistol range.

Just a reminder about our guest policy at the ranges and for Handgun Adventure Trail Practice Rounds. Any Adult Member may bring a guest or guests to use these facilities. There is a \$3 Guest Fee for using the rifle and handgun ranges and a \$1 fee for GUESTS OF A MEMBER for practice rounds on the Handgun Adventure Trail. Fees must be paid before shooting begins.

ROCKY MOUNTAIN ELK FOUNDATION GRANT

The Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation is known for its promotion of habitat for elk and other wildlife. They also are interested in promoting the shooting and hunting lifestyle among youth as well as adults. A request was made by Black Ash Sportsman Club for a grant from the RMEF state fund for help in paying for a new trap machine that benefits the Maplewood School Trap Team.
